



State-of-the-Art Training Facilities have arrived!

TestSafe's training facilities were recently modernised with the purchase of new carpet and chairs for Seminar Room 1 and new chairs for Seminar Room 2A and 2B. Additional equipment consisting of a combination VCR/DVD player, motorised drop down screen, a ceiling mounted data projector and a SMART Sympodium Console mounted on a lectern.



The SMART Sympodium ID250 is similar to a flat panel monitor and gives the presenter the ability to deliver dynamic presentations. With the Sympodium ID250, you can write notes, annotate over applications, present multimedia and save your work in a single file, all from the interactive screen.

These features make it possible to eliminate the need for an electronic whiteboard or overhead projector. It is the same technology used by television commentators during cricket matches. Wireless keyboards and mice are used to enable presenters to move freely around the room for greater audience interaction.



The Conference Room received new carpet, a 60" plasma screen and a combination VCR/DVD. The plasma screen has the ability to be connected to computers. It is hoped in the near future that this equipment will be used for video conferencing.

The new chairs enable up to fifty people to be seated in Seminar Room1. The chairs can be arranged in different configurations to suit requirements. If more room is required for break out groups we can accommodate this too.
